Dear Mr. Singer-Vine:

This is a final response to your July 22, 2024 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. The Office of the Secretary of Defense/Joint Staff (OSD/JS) FOIA Requester Service Center received your request on July 22, 2024, and assigned it FOIA case number 24-F-1577. We ask that you use this number when referring to your request.

The Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA), a component of OSD, conducted a search of their records systems and located 438 pages determined to be responsive to your request. Mr. Dean Vlahopoulos, Acting General Counsel, DSCA, in his capacity as an Initial Denial Authority, has determined that portions of the enclosed 379 pages are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6), information which, if disclosed, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals. Please note that we have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying exemptions under the FOIA in the processing of this request.

The review also determined that the U.S. Army, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), Department of the Navy (DON), and U.S. Air Force (USAF), would have cognizance over the remaining 59 pages. As such, we have referred the following to those agencies for direct response to you: Army, 6 pages; DLA, 16 pages; Navy, 19 pages; and USAF, 18 pages.
